Create a fact file about a city of your choice. Things to consider might be the population, the climate, the animals that live there etc.	Use a balloon to create a globe using papier mache. Compare the size of the UK to other continents.	Look in your local supermarket to find food products that have a fair trade symbol.
What might a typical meal look like for a child in the country you choose to study? You could create a menu to show their food off.
