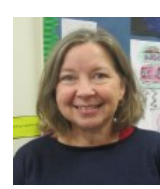

Times of the school day

Curriculum

At Catshill First School and Nursery, we follow the National Curriculum and use topics to enthuse the children in the learning.

The planned topics for Year 2 for 2019-20 are:

Autumn 1 :	Muck, Mess, Mixtures and Monsters
Autumn 2 :	Spellbound
Spring 1 :	Towers, Tunnels and Turrets
Spring 2 :	Land Ahoy
Summer 1:	Shipwrecked
Summer 2:	Secret Garden

Please note that these topics could change if opportunities arise or children's interests take us in a different direction.

Home Learning

Each half term, we send home some ideas for homework projects that will 'lock in the learning' at home. In Year 2, we also expect children to read regularly at home (5 times per week) and complete other homework that is sent such as spelling/phonics or maths work. We thank parents for their support with this. These are some examples of online resources that can be accessed at home



E-Safety

We regularly discuss e-safety with our children and monitor their use of the internet in school. At the beginning of term, we will send home an AUP (Acceptable Use Policy) for you and your child to sign. Please discuss this at home and talk about the importance of staying safe online.



Class Assembly

As well as the Nativity play at Christmas time, we hold class assemblies throughout the year, look out for details in our newsletter and website.



Key Stage 1 SATS

At the end of Year 2, all children are assessed in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science. Children are given 'tests' and the results of these along with other evidence are used to give an assessment grade. You will be informed of this in your child's end of year report. We will hold parents' meetings to give you further information.



Food and Drink

Since the introduction of Universal Infants Free School Meals all children from Reception to Year 2 are provided with a free hot school meal. These meals are provided by Shire Services, part of Shropshire County Council and cooked at Catshill Middle School.

Children are provided with a free piece of fruit during the morning and milk is available to purchase through our milk supplier Cool Milk, children who receive free school meals (not universal) are entitled to free milk. If you require information please contact the school office. Water is available freely during the day to keep the children well hydrated.

Uniform

Our school uniform consists of the following:-

White polo shirt

Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan. This can be with or without the school logo.

Grey/black trousers (for boys or girls)

Grey skirt/pinafore. Blue and white gingham dress in summer if you wish.

Black shoes. These must be made of a polishable material.

No trainers are permitted.

PE Kit

 black pumps.

PE kits must be kept in school at all times during term time.



Medicines

Any medicine that your child needs throughout the day should be brought to the school office. You will need to fill in a medication form giving details of the medicine, time and dose required.

The medicine must then be collected by a parent/carer from the office at the end of the day.

Absence Reporting

We continually strive to improve attendance for the pupils in our school as good attendance is linked to future success. In any case of absence, it is a parent or guardian's legal duty to notify school of the reason why. We have increased the number of ways that you can get in touch with us to report a child's absence:

1. Our answering service.

This bypasses reception and enables you to leave a direct message, 24 hours a day, on the answerphone informing us of the absence. The number to call is 01527 872913.

2. Email on

3. Text message.

4. By calling into the school office to speak to a member of staff.

Please note these methods of absence reporting should be used in addition to informing the class teacher.

All absences must be reported by one of the methods above by 9.15am.

The information we need is your name, your child's name, your child's class and the reason for their absence. We may still contact you for further information.

Please remember that sickness and diarrhoea require a 48 hour absence after the last episode of either.

If we are not informed and we cannot contact you to establish the whereabouts of your child, we may carry out a home visit.
