# **Food and Drink**

Meals are provided by Shire Services, part of Shropshire County Council and cooked at Catshill Middle School. In Key Stage Two children can buy a hot meal at a cost of £2.30 per day. Named envelopes should be sent in to school on a Monday for the week ahead.

Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan. This can be with or without the school logo. Grey/black trousers (for boys or girls)


Grey skirt/pinafore. Blue and white gingham dress in summer if you wish. Black shoes. These must be made of a polishable material. No trainers are permitted.

## **bsence Reporting**

We continually strive to improve attendance for the pupils in our school as good attendance is linked to future success. In any case of absence, it is a parent or guardian's legal duty to notify school of the reason why. We have increased the number of ways that you can get in touch with us to report a child's absence:

I. Our answering service. This bypasses reception and enables you to leave a direct message, 24 hours a day, on the answerphone informing us of the absence. The number to call is 01527 872913.

3. Text message. Please text 07384 578468.

4. By calling into the school office to speak to a member of staff.

Please note these methods of absence reporting should be used in addition to informing the class teacher.

All absences must be reported by one of the methods above by 9.15am. The information we need is your name, your child's name, your child's class and the reason for their absence. We may still contact you for further information. Please remember that sickness and diarrhoea require a 48 hour absence after

the last episode of either.

If we are not informed and we cannot contact you to establish the whereabouts of your child, we may carry out a home
