Here is the Maths link for Summer Week 2 <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/>

This week is all about **length**. The children will be using the vocabulary shorter and longer. You could have a hunt around your homes to compare the length of different objects. Which objects are shorter? Which objects are longer? Why do you think that?

The next step is to estimate length and use a ruler to measure the length of objects in centimetres. We would show the children that to measure accurately you place the end of the ruler so the very first line marked zero is lined up with the end of your object. We would tell the children that to find the length they are to look at the opposite end of the subject they are measuring and find the last number on their ruler that is alongside the object.

Building on from this there are then questions using the four operations ($\times \div + -$) and word problems to solve.

Questions like this will require the children to use the symbols:

> greater than

< less than

Write <, > or = to compare the statements.

a) $39 \text{ cm} + 9 \text{ cm}$ 47 cm

b) $22 \text{ m} - 6 \text{ m}$ $0 \text{ m} + 15 \text{ m}$

c) $4 \text{ cm} + 13 \text{ cm}$ $20 \text{ m} - 3 \text{ m}$
