Write a story about being shipwrecked on an island. Describe what happened, what you saw and how you felt. Can you illustrate your story?

Outdoor walk

If you went for a walk along a coast line what do you think you might see? List and explain all the things you might see on a beach if you went for a walk. Can you illustrate this also?

<u>Safe internet search with</u> <u>permission from your parents. Do</u> it together as a family.

Find fiction and/or non-fiction about being shipwrecked or coastal areas.

Research

Research amazing facts about the coast either in the United Kingdom or a different country. Maybe you could compare a beach here you have visited to one abroad. Write up your findings.

Beach visit

Have to been to the beach? What was it like? Write a description of what your day was like on the beach. What did you do? What did you see? How did you feel?

Get creative

Create a 3D animal that is found by the seaside.

Consider what recycling materials you could use.

Can you find out some facts about the animal you have created?
Write them down to share.

<u>Artists</u>

What artists do you know that paint seaside pictures? Find out about the artist. Have a go at painting/ drawing your own seaside picture. What will you include in it?

<u>Miniature seashore garden</u>

Using natural materials create a miniature seaside garden. Create it in a box so that it is easily transported.
