



# Unplugged games

<b>Forehead Detective</b>  Everyone takes it in turn to have a post-it note stuck on their forehead with the name of a well-known person on it. Players have to ask 'yes/no' type questions until they find out who they are.	<b>Gargle a Song</b>  Are you brave enough?! Fill a glass, sing a song. The others must try to guess which one.	<b>Wink Murder</b>  You need a playing card for each person (make sure one is the Ace of Spades!) The person who gets the Ace of Spades is the murderer, who 'kills' a person by winking discreetly. If someone is winked at they have to slump and play dead. Everyone else tries to identify the murderer. A wrong challenge means you are out of the game.
<b>What's Wrong?</b>  Players split into teams and one team leaves the room. While they are out, five objects are moved. The team has 2 minutes to identify what is different.	<b>Stare Contest</b>  Put players into pairs. Each pair tries to stare at the other person without blinking (or laughing). The world record is 22 minutes – can you beat it?	
<b>I went to the shop and bought...</b>  An apple, a banana... Players take it in turns to repeat original item, and add a new one – see how far you can get! For older children you can make it trickier by following the letters of the alphabet.	<b>Charades</b>  Each team thinks up a list of phrases: song, book or film titles, proverbs, and so on. Team 1 gives the first one to a player on team 2, who has to act it out for the rest of their team. When they guess it swap over.	<b>Likes and Dislikes</b>  Everyone writes down a list of five things they like and 5 things they don't like. These are then given to one player who reads each list out in turn. Everyone to guess who wrote the list!
