


Week 4 of our Dinosaur topic.

*Discuss similarities and differences between the two dinosaurs, write how the dinosaurs are similar and different using words collected.

*Look at the pattern of rhyming words in the story. Can you make your own collection of rhyming words?

*What are 'herbivores'?

- Find out about the different kinds of dinosaurs mentioned in the story. Can you write a report about each one?

-Create your own dinosaur quiz using the dinosaur information you have found out.


This week we are revising ue and aw.




