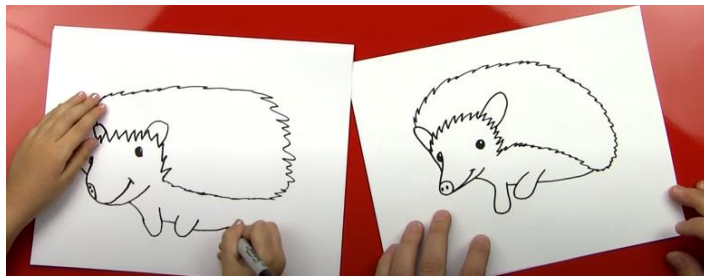
#### Questions

Write a diary, imagine that you are a hedgehog and write an account of what your day is like. What do you do when you wake up until you go to sleep?

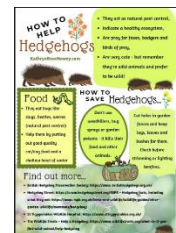


Or/and
