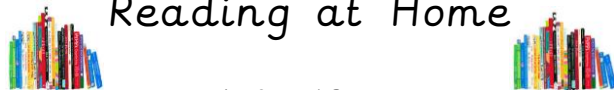

Reading at Home

Aim to read for 10 minutes each day. This could be any book and can be your child reading, you reading to your child or a mixture of both.

Home Learning

Here are some ideas of activities you could do at home which are linked to our topic.

- Autumn Walk - go on a walk to see what changes are happening now we are coming into Autumn. Can you collect natural objects which show signs of Autumn?
- Create a picture of how you celebrate with your family. This could be Bonfire Night, Halloween, Diwali or later on... Christmas.
- Record celebrations with your family - take photos or videos and put them onto Tapestry.
- Practise singing the Jolly Phonics and tricky word songs

Word Games

Your child has brought home a CVC word game activities pack. This is for you to use at home and keep. Try out some of the activity suggestions and record these on Tapestry.

Tricky and High Frequency Words

Tricky words are words which children need to recognise and say them when they see them.

High frequency words are words that appear regularly in stories.

Children need to learn to recognise them without needing to segment them

The tricky words and high frequency words your child has been learning are attached inside your child's reading record to practise at home.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will continue to build the friendships in our class. We will also continue to develop our social skills through playing simple games together.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be role playing the stories we are reading. We will also explore paints, clay, junk modelling and other materials to create rockets, bonfires, firework pictures and festival decorations.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring festivals people celebrate - Bonfire Night, Diwali and Christmas. We will also be learning about technology and use computers to create art work. Focusing on keyboard and mouse skills.

Physical Development



We will develop our core muscle control and upper body strength through using the trim trail.

We will also continue to develop our gross motor skills with Miss Christopher.

Mathematics



We will be exploring 1, 2 and 3 and how we can make these amounts. We will explore one more and one less and how to find this. We will also explore 2D shapes - circle, square, triangle, rectangle.

Communication and Language

We will explore our stories by asking: Who? Where? When? What happened? We will explore simple concepts: We will explore positional language: in, on, under, behind, next to, etc.

Literacy

We have learnt the letter sounds:
s a t p i n m d g o c k
We will continue to learn more sounds.
