Times of the school day

Year I is in Key Stage I.

School starts between 8.45am and 9.00am. The children in KS1 finish between 3.10pm and 3.25pm.

Please drop off and collect your child at their classroom door.

Curriculum

At Catshill First School and Nursery, we follow the National Curriculum and use topics to enthuse the children in the learning.

The planned topics for Year I for 2020-21 are:

Autumn 1 : Marvellous Me Autumn 2 : Splendid Skies

Spring I: All Creature Great and Small

Spring 2 : Enchanted Forest
Summer 1: Land Before Time
Summer 2: Bright Lights, Big City

Please note that these topics could change if opportunities arise or children's interests take us in a different direction.

Home Learning

Each half term, we send home some ideas for homework projects that will 'lock in the learning' at home. In Year I, we also expect children to read regularly at home (5 times per week) and complete other homework that is sent such as phonics. We thank parents for their support with this. These are some examples of online resources that can be accessed at home.



E-Safety

We teach children about safe use of the internet throughout the year. You and your child will be asked to sign an Acceptable Use Agreement before they can use devices in school. Head to thinkuknow.co.uk for more information.

Class Assembly

As well as the Nativity play at Christmas time, we hold class assemblies



throughout the year, look out for details in our newsletter and website.

Phonics

In Year I, we learn phonics each day using sound buttons. These help children read words with digraphs (2 letters that make one sound). We also use 'alien' words to practise our phonics. These are nonsense words that the children blend without meaning, such as glag and spruck. In June, the children will be asked to read 40 real and nonsense words for the Phonics Screening Check. Look out for details of phonics workshops in the Autumn Term where you will receive resources and tips to help your child at home.



All Year I pupils will be assessed in their phonic knowledge in June 2022.

Food and Drink

Since the introduction of Universal Infants Free School Meals all children from Reception to Year 2 are provided with a free hot school meal. These meals are provided by Shire Services, part of Shropshire County Council and cooked at Catshill Middle School.

Children are provided with a free piece of fruit during the morning and milk is available to purchase through our milk supplier Cool Milk, children who receive free school meals (not universal) are entitled to free milk. If you require information please contact the school office. Water is available freely during the day to keep the children well hydrated.

Uniform

Our school uniform consists of the following:-

White polo shirt

Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan. This can be with or without the school logo. Grey/black trousers (for boys or girls)

Grey skirt/pinafore. Blue and white gingham dress in summer if you wish. Black shoes. These must be made of a polishable material. No trainers are permitted.

Please ensure that all uniform and PE kit is clearly labelled.



PE Kit

PE kit consists of: white t-shirt; black shorts; and black pumps.



On PE and Forest School days, children must come to school wearing clothes suitable for these sessions.

Medicines

Any medicine that your child needs throughout the day should be brought to the school office. You will need to fill in a medication form giving details of the medicine, time and dose required.

The medicine must then be collected by a parent/carer from the office at the end of the day.

Absence Reporting

We continually strive to improve attendance for the pupils in our school as good attendance is linked to future success. In any case of absence, it is a parent or guardian's legal duty to notify school of the reason why. We have increased the number of ways that you can get in touch with us to report a child's absence:

Our answering service.

4. By calling into the school office to speak to a member of staff.

Please note these methods of absence reporting should be used in addition to informing the class teacher.

All absences must be reported by one of the methods above by 9.15am.

The information we need is your name, your child's name, your child's class and the reason for their absence. We may still contact you for further information.

Please remember that sickness and diarrhoea require a 48 hour absence after the last episode of either.

If we are not informed and we cannot contact you to establish the whereabouts of your child, we may carry out a home visit.
