School Start Time Whilst we have a flexible start time between 8.45 and 8.55 we do not have staff on duty in the playground before this time. We ask that parents/carers remain with their child until they have gone into school or that they are in the care of another responsible adult.

Dogs As you are all aware dogs are not permitted anywhere on the school grounds but we also ask that if you have your dog with you in the areas surrounding school that they are kept under close supervision and control at all times.
