### Spellbound - Creative Homework Projects

*Please complete at least ONE of the tasks. Here are some ideas to help you. Please bring to school week of 10<sup>th</sup> December Good Luck!*

<p><b><u>Puppet making</u></b> Work with an adult to produce your own magical puppet. Does your puppet come out of a hat? Is it a ventriloquist puppet?</p>	<p><b><u>Become an author</u></b> Share stories and poems about stories with magic in with your grown-ups. Take on the role of storyteller for any younger members of your family. Bring them into school and share with the class.</p>	<p><b><u>Book review</u></b> Complete a book review for a story you have read that has magic in it. If you need a book review template ask your teacher to give you one.</p>
<p><b><u>Library visit</u></b> Find fiction and non-fiction books at home (or in the local library) about magic.</p>	<p><b><u>Research</u></b> Research a famous magician. What tricks were they famous for? How did they learn to do magic tricks. Write a fact file about them.</p>	<p><b><u>Magic show</u></b> Can you do a magic trick? Bring your magic trick into school to perform in front of your class.</p>
<p><b><u>Get creative</u></b> Create a magician's hat and wand. What materials could you use? How could you make it look magic?</p>	<p><b><u>Magic show</u></b> Watch a magic show. What tricks did the magician do? How do you think they did them? Share your ideas with the class.</p>	<p><b><u>Authors</u></b> What authors do you know write books with magic in, make a list of those books including the title. How many of these books have you read?</p>
