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Personal, Social and Emotional Development

With a new intake in January we will be working on ensuring that the Nursery routines and expectations remain consistent as well as welcoming some new friends.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore a range of art activities this half term including Winter Collages, patterns and paint. Through paint we will explore colour mixing as well as using a variety of media to paint with such as ice.

Understanding the World

This will include exploring ice and snow, the children will be able to use their senses to touch and see what happens to ice when it gets warmer as well as problem solving how they can retrieve objects out of the ice if they have become 'frozen'.

<u>Winter</u> Wonderland

Our topic this term is about exploring the Winter and the cold.

We will begin by exploring and looking at ice and snow and the changing states of these elements. We will also learn about the animals who live in cold places like the Arctic and Antarctic.

Physical Development

During our PE sessions we will be using the gymnastics apparatus to strengthen our core by climbing and travelling in, on and under the different tables and benches. We will also continue to work on independence when dressing and putting on coats, gloves and hats.

Mathematics

We will be practising our 1:1 counting skills this half term as well as our numeral recognition. The children will be able to explore shape and space through a variety of construction activities available.

Communication and Language

This topic will introduce a range of new vocabulary to the children and we will embed this through talk and through focussed sessions of Concept Cat and Nursery Narrative.

Literacy

There are a wide range of books we will be using to support this topic, starting with 'One Snowy Night' a Percy the Park Keeper book. When looking at animals we will be using a range of non-fiction books and the computer to find out more about the animals we encounter.
