

#### Dear Parents and Carers

I have been delighted this week to add over 300 new books to our school library. The books include fiction and non-fiction and are already being loved by our children.

It is essential to follow up the treatment a week later to make sure that any eggs that have hatched are got rid of too.

### Healthy Snack and Lunch


At playtime, we ask that children have a healthy snack and remind you that we are a nut free school.

Please swap crisps and chocolate for healthy snacks at playtime. Some ideas would be carrot sticks, fruit/cheese strings, yoghurt tubes, boxes of raisins or maybe breadsticks. All KS1 children are given a free piece of fruit each day and if we have any spares, we give these to the KS2 children.

Some children's lunchboxes are filled with many unhealthy choices. Talk to your children about what they might like to eat at lunchtime to avoid the chocolate and crisps options every day. For example, wraps, rice cakes with cheese or ham, sandwiches, cucumber and pepper strips, yoghurt or maybe jelly pots with fruit in. These foods, along with plenty of water, will help your child to stay alert and focused during the afternoon. 


