Remote Learning

Like all schools, due to the Covid 19 pandemic, we have to put in plans for the continuation of children's education should a child be isolating, we need to close one of our bubbles or we are asked to lockdown. The Government has made it clear that schools will remain open as long as possible and First Schools would be among the last to close. Our tiered response was shared with you via Epraise earlier this week.

Individual absence - If a child is absent due to Covid 19 (perhaps they are showing symptoms, awaiting a test or isolating due to a family member having a positive test), we will send out a work pack with 3-4 days worth of learning. This work is linked to the child's current topic and learning. If they continue to be absent, a further work pack will then be sent. This will all be sent via Epraise.

Bubble Closure - If a positive diagnosis of Covid 19 occurs for an adult or child in one of our bubbles and we are asked to close, we would offer remote learning opportunities which link directly to the learning that would have been taking place in the classroom. There will be daily lessons/activities in English, maths, reading, spelling/phonics and topic. From the second day of closure, your child's class teacher will also offer a daily check in. All work and links will be sent out via Epraise. Photos of work will be able to be sent back to the teacher for feedback.

Remote Learning Books - Today, your child will bring home an exercise book which we would like you to store carefully ready for use if your child's bubble has to close. Please keep it safely so your child can do their school work in it if required. We very much hope that you won't need to use it but want to be ready just in case.




Parents Evening Autumn 2020

ARRIVING LATE TO SCHOOL

We are restricting the use of the front entrance to school for pupils. This is to keep our children safe by reducing the chances of pupils from different bubbles cross contaminating within the school. Our extended opening time in the morning should support most parents who are running late and we thank parents for keeping within these extended times. Those who are late will need to sign their child in at the school office then take their child to the glass corridor (between school and Children's Centre) to await a member of staff who will escort their child to class.





Children should come to school in their PE kit or Forest School clothing on their allocated days (details of which can be found here). Please ensure that clothing for Forest School is suitable and appropriate for the weather conditions on that day. Children may wear trainers for PE as, where possible, sessions will be taken outside.

New Reading Books
