

Having had a number of new confirmed cases of Covid 19 across the school this week, we have been asked by the Local Outbreak Response Team (LORT) to draw your attention to the information below.

The situation continues to be monitored on a daily basis.

We would advise any member of your household to take a PCR test if they are showing any of the symptoms below.

Cough
Runny nose
Loss of taste/smell
Raised temperature
Headache
Nausea
Sickness and diarrhoea
Lethargy
Rash on torso

Anyone with symptoms should remain at home awaiting the results in an attempt to manage infection control.

We would also suggest that you consider taking additional precautions to limit the spread of infection by reducing their contacts with others outside the school, avoiding close contact with those who may be clinically vulnerable.

Please keep us fully informed or call us for advice if your child shows any symptoms.

We have a limited number of postal PCR tests in school for those who are unable to attend the test centre.

We are aware that there are other children, in other classes, who are currently awaiting results of tests and thank parents for their vigilance at this time.

The school remains open and providing your child remains well and symptom free, they can attend as normal. This is being kept under review by LORT.
















Parents Evening



Thank you also to those who donated books - these are always welcome.


Worcester Warriors Rugby Opportunity


Click on the Leicester match and select seats When it says select Stand choose East Stand Upper or Lower

™Morrisons - Good to Grow

Just a reminder that Morrisons are running a scheme called 'It's Good to Grow' where anyone who shops in Morrisons and uses their 'More' loyalty scheme card can earn tokens that can be donated to a school and used in exchange for gardening equipment. Every £10 spent in Morrisons earns 1 token. The scheme runs from 6th September to 24th October with a period of one week after that to donate tokens.

If you do shop in Morrisons and use the More card, please donate any accrued tokens to our school! To do this you must be registered for the My Morrisons app, login and donate tokens to our school. You will need to link your account to our school.



Car Park - Important Notice




The car park at Catshill First School and Nursery is for use by school staff only. The only exception to this rule is when access is required to the disabled parking space.

Children must NOT be on the school car park at ANY time. All Access to the school premises must be via the pedestrian footpath and NOT through the car park.


<u>Please note the signage on the gate requesting that it is kept closed at all times. This is </u> for the children's safety.
