Model

Can you make a model of a famous building or natural wonder?

Find books (including atlases) about World Wonders. Use the contents page and index to find information.

Research

Use Google Earth to find the world's highest mountain or the Taj Mahal.

Can you visit your local library and research a 'wonder of the world?' Write a fact file detailing information about it.

Get creative

Make a paper mache globe and show all the countries, seas and oceans on it. Can you add the names of each country, sea and ocean?

Can you paint, collage or sketch a 'wonder of the world?' You could create a map of the world using different colours for each continent.

Mathematical challenge

Can you find out the distance from Catshill First School to a different country's capital city? Use Google Maps with an adult.
