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
## Unlocking the Learning

<p><b><u>Become an author</u></b> Write and draw a magical story that includes detail about the setting in different seasons. Remember we have read the story Winter's Child by Angela McAllistar.</p>	<p><b><u>Weather Reporting.</u></b> Keep a weather diary. Create your own grid and record what the weather is like each day. You could use weather symbols and words to record what you have noticed.</p>	<p><b><u>Collage</u></b> Create your own art using items from nature - use autumn-coloured leaves, pine cones, seeds, acorns to make your own natural pictures. Take a photo or draw a picture of your picture.</p>
<p><b><u>Library Hunt</u></b> Can you visit your local library and research about different countries and their climate/ weather. Write a fact file detailing information about it.</p>	<p><b><u>Research</u></b> Can you research the different weather symbols? What does each symbol mean? Can you create a chart to show what each symbol means?</p>	<p><b><u>Artists</u></b> Can you paint, collage or sketch a scene using autumnal colours or leaves?</p>
<p><b><u>Rising Stars</u></b> Log onto Rising Stars. Read a story and complete the quiz. Write a book review. Get a reading review template from your teacher if you would like one.</p>	<p><b><u>Outdoor walk</u></b> Go for a walk and take photos or draw pictures of the sky and clouds. Can you create a display using your photos with captions written for each one? What does our current season show?</p>	<p><b><u>Model</u></b> Can you make a model that shows a season? Maybe use an old shoe box or cereal box. What will the ground look like? What will the sky look like?</p>



As scientists we will investigate materials and their properties. We will be testing different materials and how absorbent or waterproof they are. We will be investigating what the best material is for a shelter for a human.

As writers we will write narratives using a range of punctuation and include detailed descriptions of our adventures. We will focus on noun phrases and simple sentences.

As mathematicians we will be working on securing their number skills with a focus on bonds to 20, place value of numbers to 100 and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

As geographers, we will learn about the weather and the seasons. We will focus on the local area as well as rest of the UK. We will observe patterns and changes in the weather.
