
It was lovely to celebrate harvest with the children in school on Monday in our Harvest Assembly. Thank you to all who brought in such an abundance of gifts to share.

All donations have been given to Catshill Baptist Foodbank and now they will be shared out to members of our community.





If you need to, more than one parent can attend the appointment at the same time using different devices.
