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Unlocking the Learning

Our topic for this half term is Roman Britain, a History based topic looking at what life was like in Britain when the Romans invaded and the legacy they left behind.

We look forward to seeing the results and would like the children to bring in, or email, their completed projects to us by Monday, 13th February, so that they can share and celebrate each other's talents before the end of term. We would ask that this project reflects six weeks' worth of work, and demonstrates the children's own work, although we really appreciate your support in helping them complete their homework.

We believe it is very important that every child has the opportunity to engage with learning at home and will support however we can with this.

As readers, we will be developing our comprehension skills by continuing to analyse different text types using retrieval and inference skills. We will look at how the author has used vocabulary to convey meaning in the text.

Why did the Romans invade Britain? As Historians, we will be learning about the Roman invasion of Britain, their motives, their legacy and how the Celtic tribes felt about the invasion. We will be using a range of sources of information to investigate this period of time.

Using our computing skills, we will look at how data and information is important. We will be collecting and managing data using data logging apps on the ipads to collect data and surveys then present it graphically.

In P.E. we will be developing our skills with dance. Themed to link with our Romans topic, we will use the children's imagination to interpret characters and present these through movement.

As writers, we will be writing letters, diaries and narratives to develop dialogue and narrative writing. We will be using a range of adjectives, fronted adverbials and practising rules of speech using an adventure story set in Roman times

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As individual readers, we will focus on developing fluency and intonation through reading with an adult using modelling and paired reading.

As scientists, we will be learning about teeth and digestion. We will be making salt dough teeth to describe their role in eating and looking at healthy vs unhealthy drinks. We will then look at how our bodies digest our food.

As mathematicians, we will be further developing our understanding of our times tables to support with learning them fluently. We will be consolidating our learning so far in Y4 through quiz questions. We will continue learning how to tell the time in digital.

As Design Technologists we will be exploring how to use pneumatic systems when making a moving toy such as a Roman chariot. We will design, make and evaluate our finished product.

In PHSE, we are learning about Safety First and being responsible for our own choices and actions. We will explore different scenarios and suggest ways to manage them and keep safe.

What kind of world did Jesus want? In R.E. we will learn about how Jesus selected his followers to spread the word of God and support him with the Christian values. We will consider how this relates to us now.
