2 tickets per child, closing date is Monday 20th March, and tickets will be distributed on Friday 24th March.





The Easter Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF) is now live to book. Activities listed are free, include lunch and are open to children and young people aged 5-16 in receipt of benefits-related Free School Meals.

Providers have 15% discretion of total places that they can offer to non-FSM eligible children otherwise considered vulnerable or referred by professionals but these places are not guaranteed.

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
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Mothers' Day
