A huge thank you to Marcus, the Farmer, and Mrs Wilson for helping to make this happen.











#### Why we sleep at night

Light helps us know when to sleep and when to be awake. When we open our eyes in the morning, sunlight lets our brain know it is time to wake up. As day turns to night, our brain makes a chemical called melatonin that makes us sleepy. Melatonin is a key regulator of our body clock and is what makes us feel tired at the correct time of day.

- ★ Free School Meal Vouchers If you are entitled to FSM's the voucher for the Easter period will be issued via your email, please remember to check your spam. Unfortunately Nursery children are not entitled to these vouchers.
- ★ Reception Height and Weight Check School Health Nursing Service will be visiting on Thursday 20th April to conduct the National Child Measurement Programme to all the children in Reception. An epraise and link has been sent out for you to register (if you have not already done so).
- ★ Attwell Farm 24th April An epraise has been sent out to Reception parents/carers with further details regarding this forthcoming trip.
- ★ Year 3's Blackwell Residential A letter has been epraised out, informing you that the children in next year's year 4 are being offered the opportunity to go on a residential visit to Blackwell Court in October. The 2 night residential will take place from Wednesday 11 to Friday 13th October 2023 and will cost £210. Places on this residential visit are limited. A short meeting will be held on Thursday 20th April at 2.45pm to answer any questions you may have and to show you Blackwell Court and a selection of the activities offered. To secure your child's place, a deposit of £25.00 is due on or before 1st April 2023.
- ★ Just a polite reminder that ALL appointments/early collections need to be flagged up to the admin office, even if you have told the class teacher, so that they are aware of your child's absence and recorded accordingly. A copy of your child's appointment letter/text will be needed for their file.
