
Numbers Day

Friday 3rd March - World Book Day. Dress as a book character (or own clothes) no contribution asked


Friday 17th March - Comic Relief. Children may wear own clothes with a suggested voluntary contribution of 50p for Comic Relief if wanted

We were so excited to try on some parts of the uniform...Mrs Banks was put in handcuffs but quickly released, luckily!



Parent Workshop– Understanding Sleep @ Catshill First School and Nursery

Why do we sleep?

Why is it important?



What happens when children don't get enough sleep?

How can we improve our sleep routines?

Although this session is aimed at parents of autistic children or children with similar social communication differences the information and principles could support all children.

It is designed to be informative but non-judgemental and will allow you an opportunity to learn more about the importance of sleep and bedtime routines.

Practical advice and strategies are given but

no magic wands are promised!

The session is a relaxed one and it lasts about an hour. The first 20 or 30 minutes will be an information presentation from the autism/ complex communication needs team, and then there will be an opportunity to talk through experiences and strategies as a group.



Stephen Fessey from the complex communication needs team and autism team is running a sleep workshop at 9am on Friday 3rd of March at Catshill First School and Nursery. Although this is aimed at children with social communication needs and autism related differences this workshop would benefit all families. 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

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
