Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be using our school's Zones of Regulation and naming different feelings.

We will seek to develop independence in learning and self care tasks.

We will talk about right and wrong and learn the signs for our core expectations - be safe, be ready, be kind and be respectful.

Mathematics

We will learn to double amounts and recognise odd and even numbers. We will count, identify and create numbers beyond ten. We will investigate sharing and grouping equally. We will look at number and shape patterns, exploring spatial awareness by turning shapes.

Physical Development

We will be learning to use equipment such as bats and balls accurately and safely with our P.E. coach Mr Adams. We will be using the trim trail to build up our upper body strength and balance skills. We will develop dynamic balance along paths and beams.

In the classroom, we will practise holding pencils correctly and using equipment such as cutlery.

Our Topic:

Crowns, Castles and a Coronation

Communication and Language

We will work on taking turns in conversation.

We will use 'why' questions.

We will play games to develop listening skills: be still, stay quiet, look at the person who is talking and listen to all of the words. We will use topic vocabulary and talk in past, present and future tense.

Understanding the World

In RE, we will talk about special places at home and in our community, including special places for Christians.

We will explore how things move in water and use maps to find and explore places.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will look at famous artists and explore shade and tint. Children will be encouraged to share their creations and explain processes they have used. We will learn songs and rhymes and move to music in a variety of ways.

Literacy

We will learn digraph sounds and tricky words in phonics, *some*, *one*, *said*, *come*, *do*, *so*, *were*, *when*, *have*, *there*, *out*, *like*. We will be reading and writing simple sentences about castles and royalty and invitations to a Coronation Party.
