📌 Further Strike Dates 📌

This is an update regarding the planned forthcoming teacher strikes of the National Education Union (NEU) across the country and regionally. The dates that will be affected are; Thursday 27th April 2023 and Tuesday 2nd May 2023.

On these days striking teachers will not be available to teach lessons, take registrations or supervise during breaks. Additionally, teachers in other unions are not allowed to cover for striking staff in any way by taking their classes, doubling up and making larger groups or any other actions that are deemed to be undermining the planned industrial action of NEU members.

The NEU union represents the large majority of teachers in both schools. Having assessed the potential impact I am able to confirm that some of the classes will be able to be open on these days.

Please note that in some cases a class being open for children is different on the two days.

Catshill First School & Nursery will be open on Thursday 27th April to the following classes only:

Nursery, RM, 2FB, 4F, 4J

Catshill First School & Nursery will be open on Tuesday 2nd May to the following classes only:

Nursery, RM, 1P, 2F, 4F, 4J

The decision to close a school is never taken lightly, but in this instance, where staff have taken lawful industrial action, we have no choice but to take appropriate steps to ensure the health and well-being of our pupils. Attendance records will not be affected by these closures.

Free School Meal families will be contacted with a google form where you can book a lunch to collect from the school if you wish.

I would like to apologise to parents/carers for the obvious inconvenience that this will cause you but hope that you will understand that these strike days are set nationally/regionally and are beyond my control.




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


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
