Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We are learning to settle into Nursery routines and find where to put our belongings. We will be learning the names of the other children in Nursery and beginning to play with them and build friendships.

Mathematics

We will be exploring size and using the language 'big' and 'small'. We will be matching objects by size, colour, shape or amount. We will also look to compare amounts to see which has more or fewer.

Physical Development

We will take part in P.E. lessons. We will learn to take our shoes and socks on and off, find a space in the hall and move safely around the space in different ways. We will take part in 'Dough Disco' to build our core and fine motor muscles.

Communication and Language

We will be building our vocabulary about our bodies, our houses and our families. We will be exploring the concept of 'who' during Nursery Narrative and looking at who is in Nursery and who is in stories we read.

Understanding the World

We will explore our senses - hear, see and touch. We will find out about our bodies and name body parts - particularly our faces. We will explore how the season changes into Autumn and how wildlife in Britain keep themselves safe from predators.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore play dough, mark making with pens and pencils, creating paintings with brushes and sponges. We will explore footprints and how we can make them with paints.

Literacy

We will be looking at a range of stories and enjoying our daily 'Story Bell' where an adult will lead a story time for children to join in the book corner. We will link stories to our learning to develop vocabulary.
