The children created their own theatre with a stage and seats. We used clay to make nature prints by rolling leaves, sticks and bark into it.


























Year 4 have been exploring tints and tones using sketching pencils. They looked at blending with the B grade pencils and the different effect this can give.














Voting will start next week for our next round of catshill children's choice books.


