








On <u>Thursday 26th October</u>, we will be holding our annual Sports, Hobbies and Interests Day for all the children at Catshill First School and Nursery. On the day, we encourage the children to wear something that shows their interest, for example they might choose to wear a sports kit, a special uniform or a hobby related costume. 





🗼 Is my child too ill for school? 🛔

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell.

There are government guidelines for schools and nurseries about

managing specific infectious diseases at GOV.UK.

These say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school or nursery on the first day. Let them know that your child won't be in and give them the reason. If your child is well enough to go to school but has an infection that could be passed on, such as a cold sore or head lice, let their teacher know.

Ordering of School Dinners

We need to remind parents and carers about the procedure for ordering school meals for your child.

Dinners must be ordered for the whole week on a Monday morning. This is vital as it allows Shire Services to order enough food for all the children. We have had a number of children recently coming to the office in the middle of the week with their dinner money.

Money or cheques (made payable to Shire Services), must be placed in a sealed envelope with your child's name and class written on the front, along with the days on which dinner is required.

The cost is £2.40 per day, we do not deal with the money in school, we simply pass it on to Shire Services. Therefore, if you do not provide the correct amount for payment, you will need to wait for change to come back from them.
