Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we are learning about our feelings and how we can manage these effectively. We are practising turn-taking with support from adults. We are learning how to look after our belongings using visual cues for organisation in the classroom.

Mathematics

We will be exploring numbers 1-5, counting and representing these. We will be learning to understand 1-1 correspondence when counting. We will also be using 2D shapes to make representation of objects and people.

Physical Development

We will take part in P.E. lessons, repeating movement warm ups. We will continue to take part in 'Dough Disco' to build our core and fine motor muscles. We are also very excited to introduce 'Story Dough' a way of encouraging vocabulary through gross motor movement.

Understanding the World

We will be listening to and responding to sounds in the natural environment as well as investigating how we make sounds. We will be exploring the seasonal change of Autumn to Winter and what happens to wildlife, plants and animals during this time as an instinct of survival.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore mark making with paint using seasonal fruit and vegetables to explore the work of Giuseppe Arcimboldo. We will also use a range of multimedia such as rice, playdough and jelly to mark make in and help us express ourselves in different ways.

Literacy

We will be looking at a range of stories that link to our topic, using role play and puppets to enhance the storytelling process. We will be introducing a class 'book vote' to support the children in making independent decisions.

Talk about seasonal changes, especially how the trees are beginning to change as we head into the colder months.

You could support your child in collecting leaves and sticks to make a collage. Talk about the colours of the leaves.
