



🜡 Is my child too ill for school? 🜡

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell.

There are government guidelines for schools and nurseries about managing specific infectious diseases at GOV.UK.

These say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school or nursery on the first day. Let them know that your child won't be in and give them the reason. If your child is well enough to go to school but has an infection that could be passed on, such as a cold sore or head lice, let their teacher know.

Forest Fun is a fantastic part of our learning in Nursery, it benefits the children in so many ways such as gaining more independence and self-confidence, reducing anxiety, building resilience, and improving their communication skills.

This year our Forest Fun sessions will be held on **Wednesday mornings**, if your child does not attend Nursery on a Wednesday morning we will endeavour to fit in some extra 'welly walks' for them and will let you know these dates nearer the time.

The dates for Forest Fun sessions for the remainder of the Autumn Term are; Wednesday AM 22nd, 29th November. Wednesday AM 6th December.

On Forest Fun days please send your children to Nursery in appropriate clothing. As we go into late Autumn and early Winter this will likely be long sleeved t-shirts, jumpers and jogging **bottoms**. Your children will also need to bring with them in a named bag with additional layers such as thick socks, hats, scarves, a warm waterproof coat and waterproof trousers. An all in one suit would also be useful. If you are unsure about any of this or are unable to find any of the above items please come and speak to the Nursery staff. Most children should have wellies in Nursery already, but please check this before our first session.

Thank you for supporting this aspect of the curriculum, please come and speak to staff if you have any questions at all.

Winter Sickness Bug

As the winter season progresses we ask parents to be vigilant of usual childhood conditions. These include chicken pox, slapped cheek, head lice, ringworm and threadworm etc. Please advise us of any of these conditions when you call to notify us of the absence. Many of these conditions are easily treatable via your local pharmacy or with advice from your local GP surgery.

We also remind you that our policy in respect of sickness and diarrhoea is that 48 hours needs to have passed between the last bout and return to school.




