

★Hearing Screening - Reception ★ **Monday 15th January**

The 5-19 Public Health Nursing Service offers a routine hearing test to every child in Reception. The main reason for screening children's hearing at this age is to ensure that all children have satisfactory hearing for learning in school. Untreated hearing problems can cause difficulties with speech, learning and behaviour.

Health Care Support Workers working within the Public Health Nursing Team will soon be attending your child's school to test your child's hearing. For this to be recorded accurately on your child's records, we will ask school to provide your child's full name, address, date of birth and gender*.

Worcestershire Public Health Nursing Service is now using a digital system known as School Screener to perform the hearing tests and issue the results. Please register for a **School Screener Parent Portal Account using the link below:**





It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell.

There are government guidelines for schools and nurseries about

managing specific infectious diseases at GOV.UK.

These say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school or nursery on the first day. Let them know that your child won't be in and give them the reason. If your child is well enough to go to school but has an infection that could be passed on, such as a cold sore or head lice, let their teacher know.

As the winter season progresses we ask parents to be vigilant of usual childhood conditions. These include chicken pox, slapped cheek, head lice, ringworm and threadworm etc. Please advise us of any of these conditions when you call to notify us of the absence. Many of these conditions are easily treatable via your local pharmacy or with advice from your local GP surgery.

We also remind you that our policy in respect of sickness and diarrhoea is that 48 hours needs to have passed between the last bout and return to school.

If you are unsure in respect of any symptoms or ailments your child may have, further help and information can be found on the NHS Website.




Bikeability Balance Bike Training **Reception and Year 1**

An Epraise has been sent out to Reception and Year 1 parents regarding Bikeability Balance Bike training, which is an initiative run by Worcestershire County Council to inspire children to take to two wheels.

This is a series of school-based sessions that aim to achieve basic cycling balance for children. It involved fun games carried out on balance bikes (bikes without pedals) to develop handling and awareness. It will provide children with a positive early experience of being on two wheels and give them the skills that they will need to take part in Bikeability Level 1, which is usually delivered in school to year 4's.

Reception - Wednesday 6th December - Friday 8th December (½ hour sessions) **Year 1 - Monday 11th December - Wednesday 13th December (**½ hour sessions)

Children are asked to come to school in school uniform, with warm coats, hats and gloves.



Year 4 have enjoyed gymnastics in PE this week using our apparatus.






















🞄 Christmas Lunch 🎄 **Tuesday 19th December**

An Epraise has been sent out this week, to enable you to book your child's Christmas Lunch, if they want one. It will be served on Tuesday 19th December and costs £3.




