
















#### Visit to Bluebrook Residential Home

#### ★Hearing Screening - Reception ★ **Monday 15th January**

The 5-19 Public Health Nursing Service offers a routine hearing test to every child in Reception. The main reason for screening children's hearing at this age is to ensure that all children have satisfactory hearing for learning in school. Untreated hearing problems can cause difficulties with speech, learning and behaviour.

Health Care Support Workers working within the Public Health Nursing Team will soon be attending your child's school to test your child's hearing. For this to be recorded accurately on your child's records, we will ask school to provide your child's full name, address, date of birth and gender\*.

Worcestershire Public Health Nursing Service is now using a digital system known as School Screener to perform the hearing tests and issue the results. Please register for a **School Screener Parent Portal Account using the link below:**


## **School Council**

#### Measles 🖈

Cases of measles are rising across England. Children who get measles generally have symptoms such as fever, cold-like symptoms, sore/watery eyes, rash & spots in the mouth. However, more serious complications include meningitis and sepsis.

Unvaccinated children who have come into close contact with a person with measles may also need to be off school for 21 days. Vaccination is the best way for your child to build up immunity and to avoid disruption to their education. If you or your child hasn't been vaccinated, contact your GP for further details about getting the MMR vaccination.





## 🜡 Is my child too ill for school? 🌡

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell.

There are government guidelines for schools and nurseries about

managing specific infectious diseases at GOV.UK.

These say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school or nursery on the first day. Let them know that your child won't be in and give them the reason. If your child is well enough to go to school but has an infection that could be passed on, such as a cold sore or head lice, let their teacher know.

## → Winter Sickness Bug

As the winter season progresses we ask parents to be vigilant of usual childhood conditions. These include chicken pox, slapped cheek, head lice, ringworm and threadworm etc. Please advise us of any of these conditions when you call to notify us of the absence. Many of these conditions are easily treatable via your local pharmacy or with advice from your local GP surgery.

We also remind you that our policy in respect of sickness and diarrhoea is that 48 hours needs to have passed between the last bout and return to school.





- ★ Vouchers An Epraise will be sent out shortly informing those who are eligible, when free school meal edenred vouchers will be emailed out to cover the Xmas holiday period.

- ★ Lunch Money Just a polite reminder regarding lunch money. Can all parents please provide the correct money where possible, along with name, class and which days your child would like a lunch. All money should be handed in on a Monday morning.
- ★ Medication A polite reminder to parents that medication can only be given to the children if it is prescribed by the Doctor and is required to be given 4 times a day, as per the school policy, and a medication form completed, which can be collected from the administration office.
- ★ Contact Details Just a polite reminder that if you have changed address, phone number, email address, or emergency contact details, can you please pop round to see one of our admin staff in the office, or Epraise admin with the correct information, so that we can update your details.
- Head Lice Can all parents and carers please regularly check their child/rens hair, and follow our 'Head Lice to Dead Lice' information if they find head lice. We also recommend that all long hair be tied back in school time.
