

We look forward to seeing some fantastic outfits.



We have had a few reported cases of head lice in the school. Can parents and carers please remain vigilant and follow our <u>'Head Lice to Dead Lice'</u> information.




We also recommend that all long hair be tied back in school time. Vosene Kids - Head lice Defence Spray has been recommended by a parent.







Vaccination UK have been instructed by NHSE to administer the MMR vaccination to all school aged children who are outstanding one or both doses. The MMR would have been given at the age of 1 year and the second dose at 3 years and 4 months. There has been an outbreak of Measles in the West Midlands which have been on the rise within the last few weeks. 

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell.

There are government guidelines for schools and nurseries about

managing specific infectious diseases at GOV.UK.

These say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school or nursery on the first day. Let them know that your child won't be in and give them the reason. If your child is well enough to go to school but has an infection that could be passed on, such as a cold sore or head lice, let their teacher know.

Please make sure these items have names written in as they so easily get mixed up or mislaid!






