



🜡 Is my child too ill for school? 🌡



It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell.

There are government guidelines for schools and nurseries about

managing specific infectious diseases at GOV.UK.

These say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school or nursery on the first day. Let them know that your child won't be in and give them the reason. If your child is well enough to go to school but has an infection that could be passed on, such as a cold sore or head lice, let their teacher know.

🤒 Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) 🤒

Vaccination UK have been instructed by NHSE to administer the MMR vaccination to all school aged children who are outstanding one or both doses. The MMR would have been given at the age of 1 year and the second dose at 3 years and 4 months. There has been an outbreak of Measles in the West Midlands which have been on the rise within the last few weeks. If your child is outstanding one or both doses of the MMR, please contact their office on 01527 390030 to make an appointment.

Please Note - This will NOT be done in school and parents will be required to bring their children to a Saturday clinic at an alternative location.

- ★ FSM Vouchers An Epraise will be sent out shortly informing those who are eligible, when free school meal edenred vouchers will be emailed out to cover the half term holiday period.
- ★ School Uniform If you have been loaned any items of our school uniform in the last month (trousers, tops, shoes, trainers, PE kit etc), can they please be returned to the office, so that other children can benefit from their use.
- ★ Absence When reporting an absence can we kindly ask parents and carers to state the child's symptoms: cold, cough, rash, vomiting, diarrhoea etc.
- ★ Appointments/Medicals/Opticians Can we kindly remind parents and carers that all medical, optician, hospital, dental appointments etc, need to be reported to the admin office, either in person or via Epraise or email, so that we can record your child's absence accordingly.
- ★ Medication Medication can only be given to the children if it is prescribed by the Doctor and is required to be given 4 times a day, as per the school policy, and a medication form completed, which can be collected from the school office.
- ★ Lunch Money Just a polite reminder regarding lunch money. Can all parents please provide the correct money where possible, along with name, class and which days your child would like a lunch. All money should be handed in on a Monday morning.
- ★ Contact Details Just a polite reminder that if you have changed address, phone number, email address, or emergency contact details, can you please pop round to see one of our admin staff in the office, or Epraise admin with the correct information, so that we can update your details.
- ★ Head Lice Can all parents and carers please regularly check their child/rens hair, and follow our <u>'Head Lice to Dead Lice'</u> information if they find head lice. We also recommend that all long hair be tied back in school time.
