Write an imaginative story where you are stranded somewhere on a beach. How did you get there? How will you get home?	Research a popular holiday destination on the coast. This can either be at home or abroad. What does the destination offer and why should people visit there?	Design a poster to advertise the holiday destination of your choice. Encourage people to visit with your choice of words and images.
Write a shopping list for your family's holiday. What do you need to take with you if you are going away for a week? Maybe your parents can help you with what they would take.	Make an alphabetical list of places you can visit. Can you find an interesting fact about some or all of the places?	Design your own coastal resort. What types of activities would people be able to do there?
Can you write a diary of a time you went on holiday to the coast? You can include photographs of what you did there and tell everyone what it was like.	Research coastal features and write a non-chronological report about them. Remember to use the right features, a heading, subheadings, paragraphs, information, images and captions.	Complete some beach art. Draw shells or beach wildlife.

As geographers we will learn about the features of coasts.

Using our computing skills we will be working on how computers connect.

In PE we will be exploring throwing, jumping and running as part of Athletics.
